TRACKING AD SUBMISSIONS

- Before the collection days, the souvenir journal committee will send a tracker that includes all sales (PayPal payments and checks) for each participant
- Before these meetings, participants are required to cross review and ensure it matches their records and all ads are upload to the BOX folder.
- Online payments made be made via PayPal at <u>http://deedkcmo.org/cotillion/participants</u> You will receive via email, receipts and records when PayPal submissions have been made under your name.
- Money Order(s), Cashier's Check(s), Personal/Business Check(s) made payable to DEED can be paid in person on collection days or mailed to the DEED Foundation - Cotillion 2023, P.O. Box 16381, Kansas City, MO 64112. Include the participant's name in the memo space.
- Record cash and check payments collected for ads/patrons on the "In Person Ad Collection Form" and turn in on ad sales collection days (i.e. Dec. 15, Jan 12, Feb 16, Feb 23)
 - For returned checks, there will be a \$35.00 service charge. Returned checks must be paid along with the service charge within 7 10 business days. DEED will attempt in every way to recover financial losses attributed to returned checks. Individual and/or collective scholarships may be reduced as a result of such fiscal sanctions

TRACKING PATRON SALES

- You will need to complete the "Patron Listings 2025" form to capture all patron sales for the reporting period
 - Access the form via your Box Folder (i.e. "Patrons")
 - Open the form using "Open Microsoft Excel Online" prior to inputting patron names

- Patron listings are limited to 40 characters. Names/Businesses only. No messages are allowed.
- Be sure to update the "Patron Listing 2025" form in your BOX folder before each collection day

NOTE - Proof your list of patrons. Be sure all names are spelled correctly. Be sure to include all Greek affiliations (e.g. Delta, Kappa, Omega etc.) for your sales, if applicable.
